REDUNDANCY SUPPORT



What DWP can do to help you

- Jobcentre Plus Rapid Response Service (RRS)
 provides support to people effected by redundancy.
- Aim is to help with next steps in finding work and support with any other help that may be needed.
- DWP work in partnership with a number of organisations to help progress into work.

How to Access RRS Funding

- 13 weeks before redundancy (when under notice).
- Up to 13 weeks after being made redundant.
- Undertake an individual Skills Transfer Analysis with the National Careers Service to discuss what options are available to you.
- Other funding streams may be available.

Finding a job

- Create your own account with 24/7 365 day access.
- Create job references to the job role you want.
- Upload and manage CV's.
- Manage email alerts you have set up.
- View your job searches, job ads and applications.


